**US State Department Expresses Concern Over Ban of Israeli Shipments in Spanish Ports, Airspace**

A U.S. State Department spokesperson expressed concern on Wednesday over Spain's measures limiting access to Spanish ports and airspace to ships and planes carrying weapons for Israel.

The publisher reserves the reject, cancel, or remove any material for any reason at any time.

Production work on assembling any banner is charged at \$75 per hour, with the first hour free. Any changes to the start date must be arranged at least 30 business days before scheduled date, after that any canceled banner will be charged at 100% the price.
